The Cambridge Primary Checkpoint is a series of assessments for use in the final year of primary education and provides schools with an international benchmark of student performance. This is to help schools identify and address their students' learning needs.



Similarly, parents may use the results of the assessments to better understand their children's areas of strengths and weaknesses at the end of their primary school journey. In turn, parents can better plan for their children's course of learning in middle school so that their children can fully optimize their educational opportunities that are ahead.
